




Number of Deaths Due to Unsafe Sleeping Environments in Greenville County




Race Comparison


What We Are Saying

Successes



- Since 2012, 168 one-on-one safe sleep education consultations have been conducted.
- To date <u>No</u> child whose parents participated in this program has died.
- 19 partner agencies.
- 63 community safe sleep education trainings.

Successes



- Safe Sleep was made a priority by the SC JCLCC in 2012.
- A Statewide Safe Sleep Coalition was created.
- 2 successful safe sleep PSA radio campaigns (6 weeks in 2010 and 4 weeks in 2012).
- 6 Safe Sleep Op-eds written in 20012 & 2013.
- Numerous news interviews and news articles about the importance of safe sleep practices.
