#### **Success Protecting Kids from CO Poisoning**

It's always nice to brag on our coalitions' work, and this month thanks goes to Safe Kids New York and Safe Kids Queens for their work in passing legislation in New York City to require 10-year smoke alarms in homes. You can watch Mayor Bloomberg sign the bill <a href="here">here</a>. CO legislation was also passed in the Pennsylvania legislature, originally sponsored by State Rep. Frank Farry of Bucks County, PA. In addition, Safe Kids supports <a href="federal legislation">federal legislation</a> just introduced to protect kids from CO poisoning sponsored by Senator Amy Klobuchar of Minnesota.
