5. A child is ready for using the seat belt alone when they pass these three tests: The child's knees should bend at the edge of the seat when their backs and bottoms are against the vehicle seat back; the vehicle lap belt fits snugly across the bony hips or upper thighs (not soft

stomach); and the shoulder belt fits across the bony shoulder and chest (not across the soft face or neck.)

6. All children under 13 years of age are safest riding in a back seat.
